SomeBeachSomewhere, is a Breed changing stallion.

Who could argue with those many good judges, especially when you take a look at the North American leading two and three year old sires lists of today. They are dominated by Somebeachsomewhere and his son Captaintreacherous.

That day in January 2018 when Somebeachsomewhere had to be euthanised, still some 4 months shy of his 13th birthday, was and will be for many years to come a sad and untimely day for the Harness Racing Industry.

So the bright star in the Australian sky to carry on the Somebeachsomewhere legacy is the handsome and fast **Poster Boy**, the fastest of his sons born in the Southern Hemisphere.

Anne and Bill Anderson, who bred and raced **Poster Boy**, are backing him to the hilt in ensuring he flies the gate in his new career.

Their Broodmare band is second to none amongst the commercial breeders in Australia and they have selected six of their very best mares to be bred to **Poster Boy**.

Included are the Group One winning mares Pistol Abbey [by Western Terror], Glenferrie Shuffle [by Art Major] and Speak No Evil [by Well Said] as well as the broodmare gem Kabbalah Karen B 1.52.8 [by Western Terror], the dam of Our Little General 1.49.8 and the brilliant 2 year old filly Ladies In Red 1.52.9.

These are not the only Group One winning mares though to book a date with **Poster Boy** as Gumdrops 1.53.1, Park Life

1.53.2, Led Suitcase 1.55.8 and Left In Paris 1.56.7 have been consigned to the Book by their respective owners.

It is likely that the brilliant and often enigmatic Mark Purdon trained pacer Heaven Rocks 1.49.6 will have a little sister or brother by the Chariots of Fire winner **Poster Boy** in 2021 as the mare Mendelico is also Booked as well.
