“LAZARUS IS IN BIG PAIN”

- That was the call from Gloucester Park commentator Richard Bell as **Soho Tribeca steamed to an eleven metre victory over Lazarus** in the first Heat of the 2017 Inter Dominion.

This was the first time **Soho Tribeca** defeated the champion Lazarus and he repeated the dose in the 2018 Miracle Mile when he finished ahead of not only Lazarus but also another pair of champions in Lennytheshark and Tiger Tara by a combined margin of 48 metres.

That run in the 2018 Miracle Mile was probably **Soho Tribeca's** greatest performance even though in defeat. In one of those rare displays of courage **Soho Tribeca** sat parked for the entire Mile only to

be narrowly run down in the shadows of the post in a Southern Hemisphere record of 1.46.9.

Soho Tribeca displayed talent on the racetrack right from day one. As a 2 year old he won at his second start in a race and completed his debut season with a fourth placing in the \$288,000 Breeders Crown Final behind Our Waikiki Beach.

The distinguished four season career saw **Soho Tribeca** compete in 16 Group One races and a

further 13 Group Two and Three races. So **Soho Tribeca** never shirked a battle against Australia's elite.

Victories came on both sides of this Big Country - WA Pacing Cup, Golden Nugget and 2 Heats of the Inter Dominions in the West and then a VicBred Final, Kilmore Cup and Caduceus Club Cup in Victoria.

He joined the Millionaires Club on 24th February 2018 when finishing that brave third in the Miracle Mile.





HIS BREEDING IS A PERFECT TEN

Soho Tribeca, a son of one of the World's leading Sires **American Ideal** and the Art Major broodmare gem **Pixel Perfect** - who could argue he's not a Perfect Ten.

Owner Rob Watson probably had visions of Oaks victories after he purchased an **Art Major / Amarillen** filly at the 2008 Tasmanian Yearling Sales.

Sadly for Rob, those visions evaporated over the next couple of years as the filly to be named **Pixel Perfect** displayed very little athletic ability. So the three year old was shown the gate to the Soho Standardbreds broodmare paddock.

That decision put **Pixel Perfect** on a pathway to a pedestal - a pedestal labelled as the Greatest Australian Broodmare this Century.

Prior to **Pixel Perfect** being named the Australian Broodmare of the Year, her own dam **Amarillen** was crowned with that title. **Amarillen**, by champion sire **Fake Left**, is now the dam of 8 winners who have won over \$1.35 million between them.

As impressive as that record is, it pales into insignificance when compared with **Pixel Perfect's** production record.

American Ideal's breeding is no less impressive being by one of the great racehorses of the 1990's



and a proven sire of sires and from a daughter of one of North America's finest racemares in **Three Diamonds** 1.53.2. For the purists who believe in the power of the Rasmussen factor, then this is what **American Ideal** is - the 4th Dam of his sire is a full sister to his own 3rd Dam.
