PASTOR STEPHEN

- the USTA 2 year old Trotter of the Year just like his brother and Sire Father Patrick and Cantab Hall. He is popular again with Breeders of Trotters... as he was last season with only Majestic Son [81 mares] breeding more mares than Stephen [69 mares].

CENTURY FARROH

- he is a beautiful, athletically conformed Stallion. On the racetrack he was a millionaire son of Mach Three who raced and defeated the best in North America including Captain Crunch and Bettors Wish.

MEL MARA

- a big strong Cam Fella line stallion whose forte was extreme speed. Closely related to the "speed machine" No Nukes. A great end of season offer available **"Breed two mares for the price of one Service Fee."**



RAGING BULL

- The most handsome son of Christian Cullen with the added bonus of an Artsplace Dam. A proven sire of \$100,000 winners from very small crops in NZ, plus a rising star in the North in Village Rebel.

SOHO TRIBECA

- a superbly bred son of American Ideal and the Award winning broodmare Pixel Perfect. Defeated all the great horses of his era - Lazarus, Lennytheshark, Tiger Tara. Has over 100 Bookings for the third successive season.

YANKEE ROCKSTAR

- what a glorious, strong stallion with such a kind temperament. Sired by the first 2 year old in History to better 1.50 - Rocknroll Hanover from an Award winning Artsplace mare. Has sired four impressive 2 year old winners from his first crop of just 31 foals .

POSTER BOY

- the handsome and beautifully bred son of the legendary Somebeachsomewhere has been heavily supported throughout his 3 season breeding career to date and depending on when you read this Newsletter, there may be one Booking available to complete this 2022 season. ►

If you still have a mare to breed this season, then here is a reminder of a "juicy carrot" that may swing your decision to one of the following stallions.

- **Pastor Stephen** -
- **Raging Bull** -
- **Yankee Rockstar** -

Poster Boy, who is fully booked will also have his 2023 progeny eligible as well.

So the \$100,000 Bonus will be paid to the owner of any 2 year old Colt or Filly sired by one of the four stallions, should they win a VicBred Final in the 2026 season.

SOME INTER DOMINION TRIVIA

The Inter Dominion Series for Pacers commenced at Gloucester Park in WA in 1936, whilst a Series for Trotters commenced at Alexandra Park in Auckland in 1948.

So now the 2022 version has been run and won at Melton and a Mighty Congratulations to the connections of the two victors - I Cast No Shadow and Just Believe.

Here are some little pieces of Inter Dominion trivia ;

1. I Cast No Shadow - the first chestnut coloured horse to win a Pacers Grand Final since Gammalite in 1984. Only 3 other chestnuts have won the Pacers Final in the now 86 year History of the Inters.

[by Bylaw] in 1982

Young Pedro
[by Van Derby] in 1959

Grand Mogul
[by Adioo Guy] in 1940

2. Shadow Play became just the fifth stallion in the History of the Pacers Inter Dominions to sire the Quinella - I Cast No Shadow and Torrid Saint. The other stallions to achieve this feat are;

Bettors Delight in 2015 and 2017

Vance Hanover in 1991 and 1999.

Light Brigade in 1951.

Globe Derby in 1936 and 1939.

3. Only two stallions have ever sired the winners of Pacers and Trotters Finals ;

Light Brigade in 1951 and 1955

U Scott in 1948 and 1960.

4. Just Believe, the Trotting Champion in 2022, became the first winner of an Inter Dominion to be sired by a French stallion - Orlando Vici.
